Greenlawn Civic Association Meeting

Meeting was opened by Darryl St. George at 7:00 PM. Dick Holmes mentioned the 65th anniversary of the Lions Club. Susan reviewed the correspondence.

Darryl, Jeanne and others thanked Highway Department Supervisor and staff for their work in Town, especially recent installation of new commercial sidewalks across from and North of the Library.
